



## Accessibility Statement

*(In accordance with European and Greek Legislation)*

The website **music-instruments.gr** is committed to ensuring the accessibility of its digital content, in accordance with the requirements of European and Greek legislation on web accessibility.

This Accessibility Statement applies to the website <https://www.music-instruments.gr> and to all of its pages and functionalities.

### Legal framework

This website has been designed and evaluated in compliance with:

- the **European Standard EN 301 549 (v3.2.1)**
- the **Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 – Level AA**
- **Directive (EU) 2016/2102** on the accessibility of the websites and mobile applications of public sector bodies
- the corresponding **national transposition into Greek legislation** concerning digital accessibility

The EN 301 549 standard constitutes the mandatory technical framework for accessibility compliance for websites and digital services operating within the European Union.

### Conformance status

The website **music-instruments.gr** is **fully compliant (Fully Conformant)** with the requirements of **EN 301 549**, insofar as they apply to web content, as it meets the criteria of **WCAG 2.1 Level AA**.

The accessibility conformance was assessed through:

- manual accessibility review,
- colour contrast checks,
- keyboard navigation testing,
- HTML structure and semantic evaluation,
- assessment of interactive elements (navigation menus, forms, galleries, product listings).

## Measures taken to improve accessibility

To ensure accessibility, the following measures have been implemented:

- sufficient **colour contrast** between text and background elements
- **alternative text (alt text)** for all images that convey meaningful information
- full **keyboard operability** across the entire website
- visible **focus indicators** for all interactive components
- consistent and logical **heading structure and content hierarchy**
- accessible forms with proper labels and error messages
- avoidance of using colour as the sole means of conveying information

These measures are applied across all key functional and informational pages of the website.

## Content outside the scope of application

Some content provided by third parties or older multimedia material may not yet fully meet all accessibility requirements. Such content is reviewed and improved progressively, where this is technically feasible.
